

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AN APPROPRIATION AND DISBURSEMENT TO YWCA OF GREATER MIAMI-DADE, INC., DURING FISCAL YEAR 2018 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$53,025; PROVIDING TEMPORARY CHILD SUPERVISION SERVICES TO ELIGIBLE BROWARD COUNTY RESIDENTS; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE THE STANDARD FORM AGREEMENT WITH THE APPROVED ORGANIZATION AND AMENDMENTS THERETO AND TO TAKE ANY NECESSARY BUDGETARY OR ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE AGREEMENT AND ANY REQUIRED AMENDMENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), desires to appropriate additional funding for the provision of support services within Broward County during Fiscal Year 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the services to be funded benefit the residents of Broward County and serve a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, disbursement of approved funding for support services provided by the approved entity will be through a standard form agreement previously approved by the Board on August 22, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to authorize the Broward County Administrator ("County Administrator") to execute the individual agreement and any amendments on behalf of the Board, NOW, THEREFORE,

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
2 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

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4 Section 1. Authorized Appropriations and Disbursements.

5 The Board hereby authorizes an appropriation and disbursement of funds during
6 Fiscal Year 2018 to the YWCA of Greater Miami-Dade, Inc. in the amount of \$53,025 to
7 provide temporary child supervision services for children of a parent, caregiver, or other
8 authorized custodial representative involved in domestic violence proceedings at the
9 Broward County Main Courthouse that have no other child care options while in the
10 domestic violence courtroom. The agreement for services shall commence on
11 March 1, 2018, and funding in the amount \$53,025 is a proration of annual funding in
12 the amount of \$90,900.

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14 Section 2. Execution of Agreements by the County Administrator.

15 The County Administrator is hereby authorized to execute the standard form
16 agreement in substantially the approved form, to amend the agreement as authorized in
17 the standard form agreement, and to take any necessary budgetary or administrative
18 actions to implement the agreement commencing March 1, 2018. Nothing in this
19 Resolution shall be construed to alter the requirement that the agreement be approved
20 by the Office of the County Attorney prior to execution. Any material deviations from the
21 standard form shall be presented to the Board for approval.

1 Section 3. SEVERABILITY.

2 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the
3 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the
4 remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any
5 portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies),
6 property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability
7 hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

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9 Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
