THE PURCHASING AGENT AND THE BROWARD ADDICTION AND RECOVERY DIVISION RECOMMEND THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. AWARD open-end contract to Minnesota Multi-state Contracting Alliance for Pharmacy (MMCAP), for Pharmaceutical Purchasing Program under State of Florida Contract No. 268-000-04-1, in the estimated annual amount of \$128,000, for the Broward Addiction and Recovery Division (BARC) and authorize the Director of Purchasing to renew the contract for two additional one year periods for a potential estimated amount of \$384,000. The initial contract period shall start on date of award and expire January 28, 2016.
- 2. Why is Action Necessary: In accordance with the Broward County Procurement Code Section 21.31.a.4, the Director of Purchasing shall approve purchases \$250,000.00 and under, and \$400,000.00 or less for multi-year contracts. In accordance with the Broward County Procurement Code Section 21.135.a.2, the Purchasing Division is expressly authorized to directly purchase from contracts generated by the State of Florida.
- 3. **What Action Accomplishes:** Provides pharmaceuticals to patients participating in an addiction program at BARC.

5. OESBD: The Director of Purchasing approved a membership agreement with MMCAP on January 22, 2014. Therefore, this project will not be subject to the requirements of the Sheltered Market Program or CBE goals.

6. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: On December 10, 2013, Item 25, the Board approved an agreement with Advanced Pharmaceutical Consultants, Inc. for In-House Pharmacy Management Services. This allowed BARC to utilize contracted consultant pharmacy staff to manage and operate in-house pharmacy and client medication services, including a licensed pharmacist qualified to order and procure prescription medications on behalf of the County, directly from a State of Florida contracted wholesaler participating in the MMCAP group purchasing organization for government-authorized health care facilities. Although the management portion of the program was presented and approved by the Board, the purchase of pharmaceuticals was not presented.

The Minnesota Multi-state Contracting Alliance for Pharmacy was created in 1985 and is voluntary group purchasing organization operated and managed by the Materials Management Division of the State of Minnesota's Department of Administration for government-run health care facilities. It combines the purchasing power of its members to receive the best prices available for the products and services for which it contracts. MMCAP contracts with over 150 pharmaceutical manufacturers, and also has contracts for distributors to support the pharmaceutical contracts. Benefits include pharmaceuticals supplied through prime vendor or alternate supplier as indicated by MMCAP awards and invoice auditing services. There are no membership costs.

On an email dated January 29, 2014, MMCAP approved the membership with Broward County. The membership ID is 09030401. The wholesaler for the State of Florida is Cardinal Health 110, Inc. Therefore, all orders under this agreement will be placed with Cardinal Health 110, Inc.
