Compliance Evaluation - First Amended and Restated Agreement

The Office of Economic and Small Business Development (OESBD) has conducted an evaluation of Fort Lauderdale Business & Currency Service, LLC's (FLBCS) ACDBE participation for the Business Technology and Service Centers Concession Agreement. An overview follows:

The initial Goal on this agreement was "DBE Opportunity" and the Concessionaire's initial commitment on this agreement was 55% DBE Participation. This participation later became 55% ACDBE participation under 49 CFR Part 23.

ACDBE Compliance Comments:

FLBCS' current ACDBE participation is 55%, which is being attained through their joint venture partner SGS Services, Inc. There will be no changes to the committed level of ACDBE participation or in the respective roles of the joint venture partners. OESBD will continue to monitor this concession for compliance with Broward County's ACDBE Program Plan, Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations Parts 23 and 26, and the FAA's Joint Venture Guidance.
