URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE TO APPROPRIATE ALL NECESSARY FUNDS TO DEMOLISH AND REBUILD THE CLASSROOM BUILDING AT THE SITE OF THE FEBRUARY 14, 2018, MASS SHOOTING AT MARJORY STONEMAN DOUGLAS HIGH SCHOOL IN PARKLAND, FLORIDA, AND TO FUND A MEMORIAL TO HONOR THE LIVES LOST IN THE **DIRECTING MASS** SHOOTING: THE COUNTY **COPY** ADMINISTRATOR OF TO TRANSMIT MEMBERS RESOLUTION TO THE OF THE **FLORIDA** REPRESENTING LEGISLATURE **BROWARD** COUNTY RESIDENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2018, a lone gunman opened fire at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School ("Marjory Stoneman Douglas") in Parkland, Florida, killing 17 students and faculty; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the victims were killed in a building housing freshmen at Marjory Stoneman Douglas ("Freshmen Building"); and

WHEREAS, no student, faculty member, parent, or relative associated with Marjory Stoneman Douglas should be forced to see or enter the Freshmen Building and relive the tragedy of February 14, 2018; and

WHEREAS, demolishing and rebuilding the Freshmen Building is a necessary step in the healing process for the community; and

WHEREAS, a memorial in honor of the 17 students and faculty who lost their lives will ensure that their lives are not forgotten; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), wishes to support efforts to foster healing in the community following this tragedy on February 14, 2018; and
