

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION AND ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION THAT MAY BE REQUIRED TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017 TRANSIT SECURITY GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED NINETY-SIX THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FORTY-NINE DOLLARS (\$596,949); AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT THE GRANT AWARD, TAKE NECESSARY ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS, AND TO SIGN ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTATION APPROVED BY THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY ATTORNEY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA"), allocates grant funds for the Transit Security Grant Program ("Program"); and

WHEREAS, the Program provides funding to upgrade and sustain existing capabilities for on-board bus surveillance systems; and

WHEREAS, Broward County has the authority to apply for and accept grant awards made by FEMA, as authorized by the United States Department of Homeland Security, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1 Section 1. The Director of the Transportation Department is authorized to sign  
2 the application to the United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal  
3 Emergency Management Agency, for transit security grant funds in the amount of Five  
4 Hundred Ninety-six Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-nine Dollars (\$596,949) to cover costs  
5 related to upgrade and sustain existing capabilities for on-board bus surveillance  
6 systems.

7 Section 2. The County Administrator is authorized to accept the grant award,  
8 take necessary administrative and budgetary actions, and to sign any and all  
9 documentation approved by the Office of the County Attorney that may be required in  
10 connection with the grant application and award.

11 Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
