OF RESOLUTION THE **BOARD** OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF **BROWARD** COUNTY. FLORIDA. URGING THE UNITED STATES SENATE TO PASS THE STOP SCHOOL VIOLENCE ACT OF 2018: DIRECTING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TRANSMIT COPY OF TO RESOLUTION ALL **MEMBERS OF CONGRESS** REPRESENTING BROWARD COUNTY RESIDENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2018, the United States House of Representatives passed the Student, Teachers, and Officers Preventing School Violence Act of 2018 ("STOP School Violence Act of 2018" or "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Act authorizes the Department of Justice to make grants for the purpose of funding evidence-based programs and practices to train students, school personnel, and law enforcement to identify signs of violence and intervene to prevent individuals from hurting themselves or others; and

WHEREAS, the Act also authorizes funds for technology and equipment to deter and respond to threats of violence, including reinforced entryways and other security improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Act is now headed to the Senate for possible consideration; and WHEREAS, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners recognizes the importance of adequate training and improved facilities in the fight against gun violence, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:
