FLORIDA, APPROVING THE REALLOCATION OF \$523,722 IN FISCAL 3 YEAR 2018 FUNDING FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAXIMIZING 4 SERVICES WITHIN BROWARD AUTHORIZING THE **HUMAN SERVICES** DEPARTMENT 5 OR DIRECTOR DEPUTY DIRECTOR TO CONTRACT ADJUSTMENTS TO REALLOCATE THE FUNDS: 6 AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE 7 8 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), has approved the appropriation of funds for support services within Broward 10 County ("Appropriated Funds"); and 11 WHEREAS, based upon a review of the utilization patterns and client demands, it 12 has been determined that the support service needs of the community have changed; 13 and 14 WHEREAS, the Board desires to authorize the reallocation of identified 15 Appropriated Funds in order to maximize support services to meet the community's 16 needs; and 17 WHEREAS, the agreements with the support service providers ("Agreements") 18 recognize that funds may be reallocated, and such reallocation shall be accomplished 19 by a contract adjustment; and 20 WHEREAS, the Agreements authorize the Human Services Department Director 21 or Deputy to Director to approve and execute contract adjustments which reduce the 22 maximum funding allocated when there is an underutilization of funds; and 23 WHEREAS, the Agreements authorize the Human Services Department Director

or Deputy Director to approve and execute contract adjustments increasing the total

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annual maximum funding by ten percent (10%) or less; however, adjustments increasing the total annual maximum funding amount by more than ten percent (10%) may only be signed by the Human Services Department Director or Deputy Director following approval of the Board.

WHEREAS, the reallocation of identified funds in the total amount of \$523,722 6 increases the total annual maximum funding by more than ten percent (10%) for those Agreements listed in Attachment A.

WHEREAS, the contract adjustments to reallocate funds shall be effective on April 1, 2018, NOW, THEREFORE,

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

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- Section 1. The Board hereby reallocates and distributes the revised amounts for Fiscal Year 2018 as set forth in Attachment A. The reallocation and disbursement is based upon a review of utilization patterns and client demand to date.
- The Human Services Department Director or Deputy Director is Section 2. hereby authorized to execute the contract adjustments, as appropriate, for each organization listed in Attachment A.

Section 3. SEVERABILITY.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies),
