CBE Compliance Comments:

CBB's current CBE participation is 29.39%. Participation was verified through an independent payment verification process. In cases where reported amounts did not change, previous verifications on file were used. Information used for the payment verifications are verifications received as of 12pm on March, 27, 2018. All payment verifications were not received from the prime and/or subcontractor. The OESBD will continue to monitor this contract for compliance with the County Business Enterprise Program.
