Fiscal Impact Statement Re: Proposed Ordinance Amending Section 39 of the Broward County Code

of Ordinances, Relating to the Regulation of Signage CAO Files: 18-026.06 & 16-416.00

Summary

The proposal amends Article VI of Chapter 39 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances which relates to signs and outlines regulations to be followed in order to promote safety, and to enhance the aesthetic quality and appearance of the County. The amendments to this section of the ordinance eliminate repetition of regulations relating to signs installed or erected in the county which are found elsewhere within the Code of Ordinances. The ordinance also proposes an increase in the schedule of penalties for violations relating to the improper erection of a private sign on publicly owned property or a right-of-way. The penalties for these violations are proposed to change from \$150.00 to \$300.00 for first time violations, and from \$300.00 to \$500.00 for second time violations. The proposed ordinance also eliminates penalties for violations relating to the erection or maintenance of temporary signs not in compliance with code, as well as the display of banners, pennants, flags, sidewalk signs, balloon signs, or other prohibited signs.

Fiscal Impact

The proposed ordinance is anticipated to have no significant fiscal impact on Broward County operations.
