1 20. One (1) representative of an affordable housing developer, defined as an entity
2 or individual that uses SHIP, SAIL, HOME, CDBG, State Tax Credits, or other
3 state and federal funds when developing affordable housing, appointed by the
4 Board.

5 ~~(b) Advocates are defined as individuals who are not providers and who do not~~
6 ~~receive funding from Broward County. Advocates shall be free of any conflict of interest~~
7 ~~incurred by being an employee of a nonprofit or for-profit agency receiving funding, and shall~~
8 ~~submit a letter of resignation if a conflict develops after appointment.~~

9 (b) Individuals from the community who are not appointed to the Homeless
10 ~~Continuum of Care Board~~ HCOC may serve on task forces and subcommittees as established
11 by the ~~Homeless Continuum of Care Board~~ HCOC. Appointments to fill task forces and
12 subcommittees shall be at the discretion of the ~~Homeless Continuum of Care Board~~ HCOC.

13 Section 2. Section 12.154 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby
14 amended to read as follows:

15 **12.154. Term of Appointees.**

16 (a) ~~A M~~members of the ~~Homeless Continuum of Care Board~~ HCOC whose seats
17 rotates on a recurring basis ("rotating category") shall serve in such rotating category for ~~one~~
18 ~~(4) two (2) years~~ or until their his or her successor is appointed, whichever is sooner. All other
19 members of the ~~Homeless Continuum of Care Board~~ HCOC shall serve in accordance with
20 Section 1-233, Broward County Code of Ordinances ("Code"), and are specifically exempt
21 from the requirements set forth in ~~Subsection~~ 1-233(b)(2) of the Code.

22 (b) Upon the expiration of a term, a member of the HCOC not in a rotating category
23 shall continue to serve until a successor is appointed, under the provisions set forth in
24 Section 1-233 of the Code.

1 Section 4. INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.

2 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this
3 Resolution shall become and be made a part of the Broward County Administrative Code;
4 and that the sections of this Resolution be renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution"
5 may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to
6 accomplish such intentions.

7 Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

8 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption; provided, however, the
9 reduction in the number of advocate representatives pursuant to Section 12.153(a)(10), as
10 amended, shall not occur until the resignation or expiration of the term of any advocate
11 representative currently serving in that role as of the effective date of this Resolution.
