- 5.2.6 Notwithstanding Section 5.2.5, if a Subconsultant that elected to use the "Safe Harbor" rate completes an independent CPA audit of its fringe benefit and overhead cost factors in accordance with the FAR guidelines during the term of this Agreement, it may submit a revised Exhibit B Salary Costs with a copy of the audit for review by County's Contract Administrator once during the Agreement term. If accepted by County's Contract Administrator, the hourly rates shall be set forth on an amended Exhibit B executed by the Contract Administrator and the Consultant, provided that no increase in the Maximum Amount Not-To-Exceed Compensation is authorized due to the revision. [New section]
- 8.7 In the event of a claim, Consultant shall provide, within thirty (30) days after receipt of a written request from County, a copy of the policies providing the coverage required by this Agreement relevant to the claim and all information required from an insured pursuant to Section 627.4137, F.S. When providing copies of policies, Consultant may identify portions of the policies that are exempt from public records disclosure by identifying the relevant Florida law providing exemption for each portion the policies so identified.
