1 Shall the Broward County Charter be amended to require the county
2 commission to redistrict following the 2020 decennial census, and every ten
3 years thereafter, or sooner if necessary, by engaging an accredited four
4 year college or university in Florida which shall utilize a transparent process
5 to identify and designate nine single-member districts within the county, and
6 require the county commission to adopt a redistricting plan, consistent with
7 its Charter and state and federal law?

10 Financial Impact Statement: Pursuant to Section 11.09 of the Broward County
11 Charter, the Broward County Auditor has estimated that this amendment would result in
12 a financial impact of approximately \$85,000 in Fiscal Year 2021 and an unquantifiable
13 financial impact every ten (10) years thereafter. These costs are estimated to arise from
14 obtaining the services of an independent redistricting consultant as required by the
15 amendment.

16 Section 7. The title and wording of the Charter Review Commission's third
17 question are as follows (inclusive of the financial impact statement prepared by the
18 Broward County Auditor):

19 **BROWARD COUNTY AFFORDABLE HOUSING TRUST FUND**

20 Shall the Broward County Charter be amended to enact a new Section
21 11.11 to establish the Broward County Affordable Housing Trust Fund, to
22 provide a definition of "Affordable Housing," and to provide for the purpose
23 of the Trust Fund, the revenue sources for the Trust Fund, the continuing

6 amendment would not have any direct financial impact by itself. ~~The housing programs~~
7 ~~to be funded by this trust fund have not yet been proposed or enacted, but any housing~~
8 ~~programs funded by the County would have a financial impact which cannot be~~
9 ~~determined at this time.~~ The financial impact will depend on the amount the County
10 Commission allocates to the Affordable Housing Trust Fund and nonCounty funds
11 received by the trust fund.

21 or gross mismanagement?
