Proposed amendments to the notice requirements of Sections 39-27 and 39-38 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances and Section 27.170 of the Broward County Administrative Code for applications for rezonings, variances, and environmental licenses and permits related to property used, or to be used, as a dump, sanitary landfill, incinerator, or resource recovery facility:

Developer shall provide written notice to:

- Broward County Commissioner within whose district the facility subject to application is located;
- Broward County Commissioner(s) whose district contains property within a four (4) mile radius of the facility;
- Broward County Administrator;
- City Commissioner(s) of Broward County municipality(ies) within a four (4) mile radius of the facility; and
- City Manager(s) of Broward County municipality(ies) within a four (4) mile radius of the facility.

Broward County shall provide email notice (at the email addresses provided to the County) to:*

- Those board members of Broward County homeowners and condominium associations within a four (4) mile radius of the facility who sign up with Broward County to receive email notifications; and
- Those other persons within Broward County who own or occupy property within a four (4) mile radius of the facility who sign up with Broward County to receive email notifications.

* The notifications provided by Broward County under this section are courtesy notifications for persons who sign up to receive email notifications, and shall not affect the validity of action taken relative to an application for rezoning, variance, or environmental license or permit, nor shall failure to receive notice under this part give rise to a cause of action challenging such application.

All notices listed above shall be provided contemporaneously with the notices required pursuant to Sections 39-27 and 39-38 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances or Section 27.170 of the Broward County Administrative Code.
