10	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
11	BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

13	Section 1. Section 1-310 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby
14	amended to read as follows:
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16	Sec. 1-310. Membership.
17	(a) The MMAB shall consist of twelve (12) members to be appointed by the
18	Board of County Commissioners ("Board"). The Board shall appoint one (1) member
19	who shall be a qualified patient advocate and two (2) members at large to the MMAB.
20	The qualified patient advocate shall be a "qualified patient," "caregiver," or "close
21	relative" of a qualified patient, as defined by Section 381.986, Florida Statutes.
22	Additionally, each County Commissioner shall appoint one (1) member from one (1) of
23	the following categories:

(7) One (1) representative from the State of Florida Department of Health,

Broward County "qualified physician" with experience in ordering medical marijuana for the treatment of "qualified patients," as those terms are defined in Section 381.986, Florida Statutes.

## Section 2. SEVERABILITY.

If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance. If any Court determines that this Ordinance, or any portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

## Section 3. INCLUSION IN CODE.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Broward County Code; and that the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.
