COUNTY SHALL HAVE THE OPTION TO RENEW THIS AGREEMENT FOR THREE (3) ADDITIONAL ONE (1) YEAR TERMS BY SENDING NOTICE OF RENEWAL TO PROVIDER AT LEAST THIRTY (30) DAYS PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION OF THE THEN-CURRENT TERM. THE PURCHASING DIRECTOR IS AUTHORIZED TO EXERCISE THIS RENEWAL OPTION.

EXTENSIONS:

IN THE EVENT THAT UNUSUAL OR EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES, AS DETERMINED IN THE SOLE DISCRETION OF THE PURCHASING DIRECTOR, RENDER THE EXERCISE OF AN EXTENSION NOT PRACTICABLE OR IF NO EXTENSION IS AVAILABLE AND EXPIRATION OF THIS AGREEMENT WOULD RESULT IN A GAP IN THE PROVISION OF SERVICES NECESSARY FOR THE ONGOING OPERATIONS OF THE COUNTY, THEN THIS AGREEMENT MAY BE EXTENDED ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS BY THE PURCHASING DIRECTOR FOR PERIOD(S) NOT TO EXCEED SIX (6) MONTHS IN THE AGGREGATE PROVIDED THAT ANY SUCH EXTENSION IS WITHIN THE AUTHORITY OF THE PURCHASING DIRECTOR OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD.

15. Termination and Cancellation Provisions

For Cause: Article 13 This Agreement may be terminated for cause based on any breach that is not cured within twenty (20) days after written notice from the aggrieved party identifying the breach.

For Convenience: Article 13 This Agreement may also be terminated for convenience by the Board upon providing written notice to Provider of the termination date, which shall be not less than thirty (30) days after the date such written notice is provided.
