SUBJECT: Agenda Item 63, June 5, 2018 Commission Meeting

Mr. John M. Camillo, President, B&L Service, Inc., d/b/a Yellow Cab, has informed the Division of his intent to visit Commissioners on agenda item 63 prior to the 6/5/18 Commission meeting. He said a main message he wanted to convey was that ECPD was not holding all the new, smaller taxi companies accountable to dispatch requirements (our code requires operators dispatch vehicles when requested). The Division's position is that it has only one complaint on failure to dispatch in the last 18 months, that it is currently undertaking an audit of WAV vehicles, and that if dispatch is indeed a problem, the Division would expect that problem to be revealed during this WAV audit. If a problem is revealed during the audit, the appropriate action will be taken. My number is 954-818-7509 if there are any questions.
