2018 Fun & Safety In The Sun Summer Camp

I am requesting to utilize funding from the County's Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETF) to allocate for the District Summer Engagement Program in accordance with Section 932.7055 of Florida Statutes. The Sheriff's Office has a long standing tradition of community engagement that makes a positive impact within the community we serve. I am requesting permission to utilize Law Enforcement Trust Funds in the amount of thirteen thousand two hundred dollars (\$13,200).

#### **Historical Background**

The Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act, sections 932.701-932.707, Florida Statutes, authorizes the seizure and forfeiture of contraband articles, as well as the vessels, motor vehicles, aircraft and other personal property used in transporting, concealing, or conveying contraband. The act provides detailed procedures to effectuate such forfeitures and to dispose of the forfeited property. The law enforcement agency affecting a forfeiture of seized property may salvage or sell the property or may transfer it to any public or nonprofit organization rather than retaining it for the use of the law enforcement agency.

Such proceeds and interest earned from there shall be used for school resource officer, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, drug abuse education and prevention programs, or for other law enforcement purposes, which include defraying the cost of protracted or complex investigations, providing additional equipment or expertise and providing matching funds to obtain federal grants.

# Request

Central Broward District is requesting the necessary allocation of Law Enforcement Trust Funds dollars for the 2018 Summer Engagement Program (Fun & Safety in the Sun) which is scheduled for July 06, 2018 through July 27, 2018. The Broward Municipal Service District Park Service (Delevoe Park, Franklin Park, Roosevelt Garden Park and Sunview Park) will be the hosing site for this year's program. The Fun & Safety in the Sun is an interactive program that will provide Gang Resistance Education and Training (GREAT) along with other safety components. The district will engage over 1200 students during this summer program. Students from the Broward Municipal Service District will have the opportunity to enhance their social skills, giving them alternatives to less than desirably or destructive activities and adding structure for the summer months. The goal of the Fun & Safety Summer Program is to provide students with positive activities to relieve the boredom over the summer months and increase their opportunities for social, cognitive and interpersonal growth.

In order to assist with the funding for this year's program, a total of thirteen thousand two hundred dollars (\$13,200) from the County's Law Enforcement Trust Fund is being requested. These funds will be used to pay for planned field activities, supplies and food for the 1200 students participating in the program.
