**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Impact Statement Re: Proposed Ordinance Amending Section 27-34 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, Relating to Approving and Reporting Notice of Violation Settlements

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**Summary**

The proposal amends Section 27-34 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances. The purpose of Chapter 27 is to establish the Natural Resource Protection Code which provides standards to help prevent air, water and noise pollution and beach erosion; ensure propagation and protection of all wildlife; and ensure the protection of the public health, safety and welfare of the environment and natural resources in Broward County. Proposed changes to this section of the code would give the County Administrator authority to settle, adjust, comprise and report on settlement of claims in addition to the County Attorney. The proposed changes to the ordinance would also require that it be consistent with the regulations provided in Section 1-51.3 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances before it is considered to be accepted by Broward County.

**Fiscal Impact**

There is no fiscal impact to Broward County related to enforcement of this ordinance.
