1 **RESOLUTION NO. 2018-**2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE ERECTION OF TWO 3 HONORARY DESIGNATION MARKERS ON INTERSTATE 75 BETWEEN MILE MARKER 24 AND MILE MARKER 26 IN HONOR OF FALLEN 4 STEPHEN G. ROUSE: RECOGNIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AS THE AGENCY RESPONSIBLE 5 FOR THE DESIGN, ERECTION, AND MAINTENANCE OF THE HONORARY DESIGNATION MARKERS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN 6 EFFECTIVE DATE. 7 8 WHEREAS, Chapter 2018-161, Laws of Florida, provides for the erection of honorary 9 designations of certain transportation facilities in specified counties and directs the Florida 10 Department of Transportation ("FDOT") to erect suitable markers; and 11 WHEREAS, FDOT has been directed to erect two markers designating the portion of 12 Interstate 75 between mile marker 24 and mile marker 26 ("Roadway") as "Trooper Stephen 13 G. Rouse Memorial Highway"; and 14 WHEREAS, the Roadway is within FDOT's jurisdictional limits, and FDOT will be 15 responsible for the design, erection, and maintenance of the honorary designation markers; 16 and 17 WHEREAS, Section 334.071(3), Florida Statutes, requires that the appropriate city or 18 county commission pass a resolution in support of any proposed honorary designation 19 markers prior to their erection; and 20 WHEREAS, the Roadway where the proposed honorary designation will be erected 21 lies within Broward County, NOW, THEREFORE, 22 23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD 24 COUNTY, FLORIDA:
