12	WHEREAS, Section 1-51.3 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances ("Code")
13	provides for quarterly reporting of the settlement of claims by the County Attorney and
14	County Administrator to the Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board");

16	WHEREAS, Section 27-34 of the Code provides that the County Attorney report
17	settlement of claims arising under Chapter 27, the Natural Resource Protection Code, to
18	the Board on a monthly basis; and
19	WHEREAS, the Board believes that the settlement and reporting of claims under
20	Chapter 27 should be consistent with the process established by Section 1-51.3,

22	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF

Section 1. Section 27-34 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 27-34. Settlement.

. . .

(c) The County Attorney shall and County Administrator have the authority to settle, adjust, compromise, and report on settlement of claims as provided for in Subsection 1-51.3 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances. The County Attorney shall submit a monthly report of the settled claims to the Board of County Commissioners. The terms of Aany agreement reached between the responsible party or parties and the director of EPGMD, or the director's designee, must be approved by either the Board or the County Attorney as set forth above as provided for in Section 1-51.3 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances before it is considered to be accepted by Broward County. The failure of a responsible party to comply with an approved settlement approved by the Board or the County Attorney shall agreement for violations of this Chapter can result in the rendition of the settlement into a final order by the hearing examiner upon a motion by Broward County and finding by the hearing examiner of noncompliance.

Section 2. SEVERABILITY.

If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance. If any Court determines that this Ordinance, or any portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.
