I am writing to express my concurrence with Broward County, Florida, Grantee of Foreign- Trade Zone (FTZ) No. 25, in its Application for a Minor Boundary Modification to re-designate a portion of Subzone No. 25C, 8.9-acres, inclusive of two petroleum storage tanks Nos. 901 and 902, to be designated to be in Subzone No. 25D, as part of the Broward County's general-purpose FTZ.
