Subject: Capital Reserve Funds-Mobil Tech Center

BSO is desirous of renovating the existing Central Supply building at the Public safety Complex into a Mobile Technology Center. Funding is to be provided by BSO Capital Reserve which requires Broward County Commission approval.

The project consists of renovating the current CS building of 8800SF plus an additional 460SF of exterior workspace for a vehicle work area. The renovated facility will include an IT support area, tech support area, and secure storage spaces. Specific work includes:

- Install of a whole building generator, transfer switch and electrical
- 36 cubicle work areas
- IT and mobile tech work bench areas
- Radio shop work bench areas
- New network infrastructure fiber and data
- Additional restrooms and renovation of existing
- New office, conference and training rooms
- New HVAC
- New interior lighting and ceiling grid
- Upgraded electrical, data and fire alarm building wide
- New roofing and structural supports for rooftop units
- All interior finishes
- New furniture, fixtures and Equipment (FFE) to outfit the renovated work spaces



Subject: Facility Generator Funding

BSO is desirous of retrofitting and installing three existing BSO owned Cumming Generators currently stored at the Conte Facility for use at BSO Fleet, BSO Evidence Warehouse and at BSO District Five. Funding is to be provided by BSO Capital Reserve which requires Broward County Commission approval.

Engineering cost estimates which include all electrical engineering work, permitting, specific facility electrical upgrades as well as site work and installation are as follows

- District 5-\$115,750
- Evidence Warehouse-\$105,299
- Central Fleet-\$77,310
- Service, load test and retrofit generators-\$13,100
- Annual Service-\$5920
- 10% contingency-\$32,000

Total project cost is expected to be \$349,379. The intent of the Agency is for the project to be underway before the end of the current hurricane season.
