SUBJECT: Fiscal Impact Statement Re: Various Sections of Chapter 20 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, Relating to the Procedures by which Public Nuisance Abatement Matters are Heard and Resolved by The Consumer Protection Board

Summary

The proposal amends Chapter 20, Article VII, Division 7 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances which authorizes the Broward County Consumer Protection Board to sit as the Broward County Drug, Prostitution, and Criminal Street Gang-Related Public Nuisance Abatement Board and hear public nuisance matters. The proposed amendments would require that complaints and public nuisance proceedings be handled by the Division as opposed to the Consumer Protection Board. The amendments also outline the composition of the hearing panel needed to conduct hearings related to this ordinance, as well as how hearings are to be assigned to members of the Consumer Protection Board. The proposed changes specify how the recommended orders from the hearing panel are to be handled by the Consumer Protection Board.

Fiscal Impact

There is no fiscal impact to Broward County related to enforcement of this ordinance.
