I. REQUEST: Provide a description of the features of the product/service or Scope of Work.

Henderson Behavioral Health provides Crisis Screening and Stabilization Services to indigent adults meeting voluntary or involuntary intervention for mental illness under Florida Statute, Chapter 394 Mental Health Part 1. The Crisis Screening and Stabilization Unit (CSU) is the only 23-bed licensed psychiatric inpatient stabilization unit, in Broward County, that provides screening, assessment, treatment and stabilization of those individuals experiencing a severe emotional or psychiatric crisis who require a more restrictive setting. To ensure this critical service is available to the community, the County has funded services previously through our Request for Proposals (RFP) process. The current agreement with Henderson Behavioral Health, Inc., in the amount of \$531,000.00, will expire on September 30, 2018. However, given that Henderson is the sole provider of a non-profit CSU, we are seeking designation of sole reasonable source.
