

1 RESOLUTION NO. 2018-

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 AUTHORIZING THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION
5 AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT TO FILE A
6 LOCAL GOVERNMENT FUNDING REQUEST WITH THE
7 FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
8 PROTECTION FOR THE BEACH MANAGEMENT
9 FUNDING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM; SUPPORTING
10 PROJECTS FOR WHICH FUNDING IS REQUESTED;
11 CONFIRMING BROWARD COUNTY'S ABILITY TO SERVE
12 AS LOCAL SPONSOR AND FUND THE APPROPRIATE
13 LOCAL SHARE OF PROJECTS; IDENTIFYING THE
14 SOURCE OF COUNTY SHARE; AND PROVIDING FOR
15 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 WHEREAS, public works projects and studies relating to beach erosion control,
17 beach preservation, marine environmental protection, beach management, and
18 hurricane protection are eligible for State of Florida ("State") funding consideration
19 under the provisions of Chapter 161, Florida Statutes;

20 WHEREAS, in order to qualify for State beach management funding, current
21 State policy requires submission of a long-range local government funding request
22 which specifies projects relating to management of beaches or inlets;

23 WHEREAS, inlet sand bypassing and beach erosion control projects using
24 compatible materials, including nearshore, offshore, and upland sand, have been, and
are planned to be, conducted by Broward County as local project sponsor, with
subsequent reimbursement of the federal and State shares of eligible costs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County has
determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Broward County to pursue all

1 available funding in order to restore and maintain the beaches of Broward County,
2 NOW, THEREFORE,

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4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
5 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

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7 Section 1. The Broward County Environmental Protection and Growth
8 Management Department is authorized and directed to file a long-range local
9 government funding request with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection.

10 Section 2. The Broward County Board of County Commissioners supports the
11 beach management projects for which funding is requested from the State of Florida.

12 Section 3. Broward County is able to serve as local sponsor for beach
13 management projects and is able to provide the appropriate local funding share from
14 beach capital funds to implement the projects.

15 Section 4. Severability.

16 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the
17 invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the
18 remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in
19 part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance,
20 such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other
21 individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

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
