RESOLUTION THE BOARD OF COUNTY OF OF BROWARD COUNTY, COMMISSIONERS FLORIDA. PERTAINING WATER TO AND WASTEWATER SERVICES: AMENDING SECTION 38.18 **BROWARD** COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE "ADMINISTRATIVE CODE") TO PRESCRIBE A REVISED SCHEDULE OF RETAIL WATER AND WASTEWATER RATES, FEES, AND CHARGES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Broward County has the right to regulate the use of sewers and the supply of water within Broward County and to establish and collect rates, fees, and charges for usage of Broward County's water and wastewater facilities;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34-6 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, the water and wastewater rates, fees, and charges are required to be established following public notice and hearing, which, in this matter, have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds it is reasonable and in the best interest of the public to revise Section 38.18 of the Broward County Administrative Code to reflect the new rates, fees, and charges for retail water and wastewater services effective with all services rendered on or after October 1, 2018, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA;
