

1 RESOLUTION NO. 2018-

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 PERTAINING TO WASTEWATER SERVICES; AMENDING
5 SECTION 38.20 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY
6 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE"), TO
7 PRESCRIBE A REVISED SCHEDULE OF WASTEWATER
8 LARGE USER RATES; AND PROVIDING FOR
9 SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE
10 CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

11 WHEREAS, Broward County provides transmission, treatment, and disposal sewer
12 services to large users of Broward County's North Regional Wastewater Treatment and
13 Transmission Facility pursuant to certain agreements (the "Agreements");

14 WHEREAS, the Agreements require that Broward County review the rates on an
15 annual basis, and Broward County has completed its review accordingly;

16 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34-6 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances,
17 the water and wastewater rates, fees, and charges are required to be established following
18 public notice and hearing, which, in this matter, have been satisfied; and

19 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds it is reasonable and in the
20 best interest of the public to revise Chapter 38, Part III, Section 38.20, of the Broward
21 County Administrative Code to reflect the new rates, fees, and charges for large users of
22 the North Regional Wastewater Treatment and Transmission Facility effective with all
23 services rendered on or after October 1, 2018, NOW, THEREFORE,

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1 Section 1. The recitals set forth in the preamble to this Resolution are
2 incorporated by reference herein.

3 Section 2. Section 38.20 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby
4 amended to read as follows:

5 **38.20. Wastewater Large User Rates.**

6 The following schedule of rates, fees, and charges for Large Users of the North
7 Regional Wastewater System operated by Broward County Water and Wastewater Services
8 is effective with all services rendered on or after October 1, ~~2017~~ 2018:

22 Section 3. Severability.

23 If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any court to be
24 invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the

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1 remainder of this Administrative Code Resolution. If any court determines that this
2 Administrative Code Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any
3 individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the
4 applicability of this Administrative Code Resolution to any other individual, group, entity,
5 property, or circumstance.

6 Section 4. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

7 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this
8 Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code as
9 of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be
10 renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article,"
11 or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary in order to accomplish
12 such intention.

13 Section 5. Effective Date.

14 This Administrative Code Resolution is effective on October 1, 2018.
