2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 SUPPORTING THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING
5 ORGANIZATION'S MOBILITY PROJECT TO CONSTRUCT
6 BICYCLE FACILITIES ALONG PROSPECT ROAD FROM
7 COMMERCIAL BOULEVARD TO POWERLINE ROAD;
8 SUPPORTING FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
9 TRANSPORTATION AS THE AGENCY RESPONSIBLE FOR
10 THE PROJECT'S DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, AND
11 CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION; AND PROVIDING FOR
12 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (the "MPO") has
14 funds under its Transportation Improvement Program (FM #4359251) to construct
15 bicycle facilities along Prospect Road between Commercial Boulevard and Powerline
16 Road (the "Project"); and

17 WHEREAS, the Project is on a Broward County (the "County") road within the
18 cities of Fort Lauderdale, Oakland Park, and Tamarac (the "Cities"); and

19 WHEREAS, the MPO collaborated with the Florida Department of Transportation
20 ("FDOT"), the Cities, and the County to develop the Project to improve bicycle safety;
21 and

22 WHEREAS, the County, as the owner of the Project's affected right-of-way, is
23 committed to continue funding the operation and maintenance of Prospect Road; and

24 WHEREAS, the Project will further the goal of the Board of County
Commissioners of Broward County, Florida (the "Board"), to "[s]upport the development,
design and construction of sustainable, multi-modal transportation facilities throughout
the County, to meet the demands of residents, travelers, and businesses[]"; and

1 WHEREAS, the MPO requires a resolution from the County supporting the
2 Project; and

3 WHEREAS, FDOT will be the agency responsible for design, construction, and
4 construction administration of the Project; and

5 WHEREAS, FDOT requires a resolution from the County supporting its role as
6 the agency responsible for the Project's design, construction, and construction
7 administration; and

8 WHEREAS, FDOT will ensure that the design and construction of the Project
9 meets or exceeds the "Minimum Standards Applicable to Public Rights-of-Way Under
10 Broward County Jurisdiction," Section 25.1, Exhibit 25.A, of the Broward County
11 Administrative Code, NOW, THEREFORE,

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13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
14 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

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16 Section 1. The foregoing recitals are affirmed as true and correct and adopted
17 as part of this Resolution.

18 Section 2. The Board supports the Project to improve conditions for bicyclists
19 along Prospect Road from Commercial Boulevard to Powerline Road.

20 Section 3. The Board supports FDOT as the agency responsible for the
21 Project's design, construction, and construction administration.

22 Section 4. Severability.
