3	COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 15-176 OF THE BROWARD
4	COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES ("CODE") PERTAINING TO THE POWERS OF THE BROWARD COUNTY HEALTH
5	FACILITIES AUTHORITY; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN
6	EFFECTIVE DATE.

9	WHEREAS, Section 2.09 of the Broward County Charter and Section 1-245 of the
10	Broward County Code of Ordinances ("Code") provide for the periodic review of all
11	existing Broward County boards, authorities, and agencies; and
12	WHEREAS, in 2016, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County,
13	Florida ("Board"), through the Intergovernmental Affairs/Boards Section ("IABS"),
14	conducted its review of all existing Broward County boards, authorities, and agencies
15	pursuant to the Code (the "Sunset Review"); and
16	WHEREAS, as part of the Sunset Review, IABS provided the Board with numerous
17	recommendations with respect to these boards, authorities, and agencies ("Sunset
18	Recommendations"); and
19	WHEREAS, IABS, as part of its Sunset Recommendations, recommended
20	amending the Code in a manner that would enhance the powers of the Broward County
21	Health Facilities Authority ("Authority") under the Code as more particularly described
22	herein; and
23	WHEREAS, the Board has directed the Office of the County Attorney to amend the
24	Code in accordance with IABS's Sunset Recommendations for the Authority,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 15-176 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

## Sec. 15-176. Powers of authority.

The purpose of the authority shall be to assist health facilities in the acquisition, construction, financing, and refinancing of projects in any incorporated or unincorporated area of Broward County. For this purpose, the authority is hereby authorized and empowered:

(p) To do all things necessary to carry out the purposes of this article, including, but not limited to, preparing and distributing educational materials, increasing community outreach, and reviewing the Florida Statutes governing the authority and providing the Intergovernmental Affairs/Boards Section or its successor with proposed changes to the Florida Statutes.

## Section 2. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>.

If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance. If any court determines that this Ordinance, or any portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.
