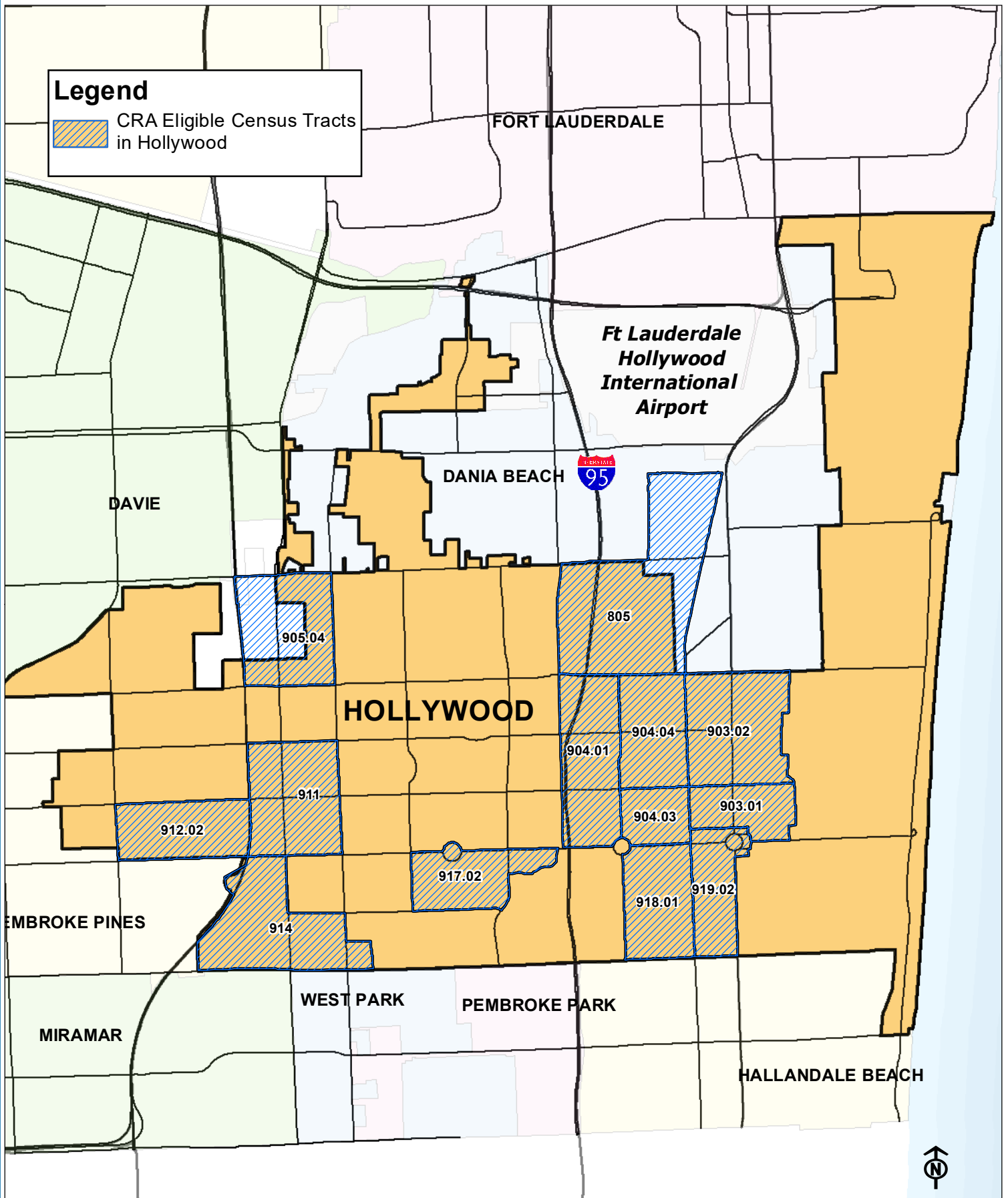

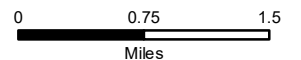
Low-to-Moderate Income Areas (“LMI Areas”) are defined as follows:

Geographical areas (calculated on a block group basis) within the City in which more than half of the residents have an annual median income (AM(), adjusted for family size, that is eighty percent (80%) or less of the AMI for Broward County, Florida, as published by the Florida Housing Finance Corporation for the applicable year. **In addition any census tract(s) where 16% or more of the population falls under the federal poverty rate shall be included. At this time these tracts are 912.01, 919.02, 904.01, 918.01, 905.04, 914.00, 917.02, 903.02, 904.03, 903.01, 911.00, 904.04, and 805.00.**
