- 1 1. Within nine (9) days after the filing of an application for licensing of  
2 a Significant Environmental Impact Facility; and  
3 2. Within nine (9) days after receipt of a license or intent to issue a  
4 license.

5 However, no applicant shall mail notice on or within five (5) days prior to a  
6 federal, state, or Broward County legal holiday. If a federal, state, or  
7 Broward County legal holiday exists within the mailing period, notice shall  
8 be mailed either at least six (6) days before the holiday or on the next  
9 business day following the holiday.

10 e. j. Within seven (7) days after mailing or emailing each notice, the applicant  
11 shall submit to EPGMD proof of notice by providing electronic copies of all  
12 notices sent, together with an affidavit that the notices were mailed on the  
13 date indicated on the notice.

14 f. k. ~~The following license applications, licenses, and intent to issue licenses~~  
15 ~~shall not be subject to the notice requirements of this section:~~

- 16 4. ~~License renewals that do not include any major modifications or~~  
17 ~~that include only minor modifications to the licensed facility or~~  
18 ~~activity;~~ and minor modifications to the licensed facility or activity  
19 that are independent of a license renewal, shall not be subject to  
20 the notice requirements of this section.

3 2. For purposes of this section, a "minor" modification shall  
4 mean:

5 (a) For parking facilities: an existing parking facility  
6 undergoing a modification that results in an addition  
7 of less than 350 parking spaces.

8 (b) For wastewater treatment plants: a modification that  
9 does not result in an increase in overall capacity or an  
10 increase in the capacity of the Advanced Wastewater  
11 Treatment system.

12 (c) For licenses to operate direct discharge from  
13 nondomestic activity: a modification that does not  
14 increase the quantity of discharge or decrease the  
15 quality of discharge.

16 (d) For solid waste management facilities and hazardous  
17 material transfer facilities: a modification that is not  
18 reasonably expected to lead to substantially different  
19 environmental impacts that would require a detailed  
20 review.
