The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida, 23 hereby authorizes the Director of the Transportation Department to sign the application 24 to the Federal Transit Administration for Low or No Emissions Grant Program funds in

the amount of Two Million Two Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$2,225,000) 2 pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Section 5339 (c) for the purchase of battery electric buses and 3 supporting solar powered charging infrastructure. The Board authorizes the County Administrator to accept a grant 4 Section 2. award, unless this Resolution is specifically rescinded, and to sign any and all 5 documentation approved as to legal sufficiency by the Office of the County Attorney that 6 7 may be required in connection with the grant application and award. 8 Section 3.
