BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the donation from Carole Reese, in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000), to be deposited in the Animal Care Trust Fund and used for the funding of lifesaving programs of the Animal Care and Adoption Division.
