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RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF THE APPLICATION OF CORPORATION REFERRED TO AS PROJECT SWING, PURSUANT TO SECTION 288.075, FLORIDA STATUTES, AS **QUALIFIED TARGET INDUSTRY PURSUANT** BUSINESS APPLICANT SECTION 288.106, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR A COMMITMENT TO APPROPRIATE THE TOTAL SUM OF TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$20.000) AS COUNTY'S BROWARD LOCAL MATCH FOR TARGET QUALIFIED **INDUSTRY** TAX REFUND PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEARS 2018 THROUGH 2026; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, the corporation referred to as Project SWING has requested that Broward County maintain the confidentiality of its name and business information pursuant to Section 288.075, Florida Statutes;

WHEREAS, Project SWING, an aviation services company located in Florida, is considering relocation of its operations to and creating additional jobs in Broward County, Florida;

WHEREAS, Project SWING has applied for certification as a "Qualified Target Industry Business" under the State of Florida Qualified Target Industry Tax Refund Program ("QTI Program") pursuant to Section 288.106, Florida Statutes;

WHEREAS, Project SWING has also requested local financial support from the Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") for its QTI Program application;

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WHEREAS, on August 14, 2018, the Board passed Resolution No. 2018-336 committing Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) as Broward County's local financial support for Project SWING's QTI Program application ("Broward County's local match") to be apportioned based on a payout schedule for Fiscal Years 2018 through 2024:

WHEREAS, on or about August 27, 2018, before entering into the QTI Program with the State of Florida, Project SWING requested an additional twelve (12) months to meet the project's job creation schedule, extending Broward County's payout schedule through Fiscal Year 2025;

WHEREAS, Project SWING has another opportunity to extend the QTI Program agreement for an additional twelve (12) months after entering the QTI Program, which would further extend Broward County's payout schedule through Fiscal Year 2026; and

WHEREAS, the amount of Broward County's local match will remain Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) while Broward County's payout schedule will be extended to accommodate Project SWING's modified job creation schedule and, if applicable, the additional extension period, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

- Section 1. The Board hereby recommends that Project SWING be approved as a Qualified Target Industry Business pursuant to Section 288.106, Florida Statutes.
- Section 2. The Board hereby recommends and approves the necessary commitment of local financial support for Project SWING as a Qualified Target Industry

Business under the QTI Program in the total amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) for Fiscal Years 2018 through 2026. Broward County's commitment for local financial support will be paid to the Florida Economic Development Trust Fund with the stipulation that these funds are intended to represent the "local financial support" required by Section 288.106, Florida Statutes.

Section 3. In furtherance of Project SWING's request for approval herein, the Board has determined that the basis of this proposed project's private sector wage commitment calculation shall be one hundred fifteen percent (115%) of the Broward County average annual wage.

Section 4. The amount authorized herein shall constitute Broward County's total commitment to this project for participation in the QTI Program.

Section 5. Severability.
