ORDINANCE NO. 2018-

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO THE BROWARD REGIONAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES COUNCIL; AMENDING SECTION 15-74 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES ("CODE"); AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

(Sponsored by the Board of County Commissioners)

WHEREAS, Section 2.09 of the Broward County Charter and Section 1-245 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances ("Code") provide for the periodic review of all existing Broward County boards, authorities, and agencies;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), has completed this review; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that amending the membership composition of the Broward Regional Emergency Medical Services Council ("EMS Council") is appropriate at this time,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 15-74 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 15-74. Membership; terms.

(a) *Membership.*

(1) Members of the EMS Council shall be appointed by the Board. The EMS Council shall consist of ~~forty-eight (48)~~ thirty-seven (37) members. EMS

1 Council members shall serve in accordance with the provisions of
2 Section 1-233 of the Code, unless otherwise provided for herein.

3 ~~(2)~~ One ~~(1)~~ member shall be a County Commissioner selected by a majority
4 vote of the Board for a period specified by the Board.

5 ~~(3)~~ (2) Each County Commissioner shall appoint one (1) member of the EMS
6 Council.

7 ~~(4)~~ (3) The Broward County Medical Examiner shall be a voting, ~~ex-officio~~ ex officio
8 member of the EMS Council and is specifically exempt from the
9 requirements set forth in Section 1-233 of the Code which provide for terms
10 of appointment to advisory boards.

11 ~~(5)~~ (4) The EMS council shall submit to the Board for consideration a nominee from
12 each ~~category~~ of the twenty-seven (27) categories or organizations listed
13 below:

11 ~~(6)~~ (5) The Board may approve a nomination submitted by the EMS Council for
 12 appointment, or the Board may appoint another individual who meets the
 13 criteria of for serving in the particular category of membership ~~to be filled on~~
 14 the EMS Council.

15 ~~(7)~~ (6) Staff assistance and appropriate resources for the EMS Council shall be
 16 provided by the Broward County Trauma Management Agency.

18 Section 2. Severability.

19 If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
 20 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
 21 Ordinance. If any court determines that this Ordinance, in whole or in part, cannot be
 22 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
 23 determination will not affect the applicability of this Ordinance to any other individual,
 24 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

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1 Section 3. Inclusion in the Broward County Code of Ordinances.

2 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this
3 Ordinance become part of the Broward County Code of Ordinances as of the effective
4 date. The sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word
5 "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or
6 phrase to the extent necessary in order to accomplish such intention.

7 Section 4. Effective Date.

8 This Ordinance is effective as of the date provided by law.
