9	WHEREAS, Section 570.07(16), Florida Statutes, preempts to the state the		
10	adoption of standards and fines for liquid fuels and requires local governments enforcing		
11	regulations related to the sale of liquid fuels to use the standards set forth by the state;		
12	WHEREAS, Section 20-9 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances ("Code")		
13	prescribes the regulations for signs indicating the price of gasoline;		
14	WHEREAS, Section 8½-16 of the Code prescribes the schedule of civil penalties		
15	for violations of Section 20-9 of the Code; and		
16	WHEREAS, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners desires to		
17	amend Sections 20-9 and 8½-16 of the Code to comply with Section 570.07(16), Florida		
18	Statutes,

23	Section 1. Section 20-9 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby

Coding:

## Sec. 20-9. Signs indicating price of gasoline and liter-gallon equivalency required.

- (a) Every person, firm, partnership, association, trustee, or corporation which that owns, operates, manages, leases, or rents a gasoline service station offering for sale, selling, or otherwise dispensing leaded gasoline, unleaded gasoline, or diesel motor fuel to the public from such gasoline service station abutting or adjacent to a street or roadway shall post or cause to be posted or displayed and maintain at such gasoline service station in a location easily visible to passing motorists from abutting or adjacent streets or roadways, a sign indicating the unit price for each grade of gasoline and diesel fuel offered for sale, sold, or dispensed. The prices stated on such sign shall disclose the highest price that the customer must pay for each grade of such gasoline or diesel fuel comply with the requirements of state law regulating the display of motor fuel prices, including the requirements of Sections 526.111, 526.121, and 531.44, Florida Statutes, and implementing regulations promulgated by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.
- (b) When gasoline service stations having signs posted in compliance with subsection (a) are not dispensing leaded gasoline, unleaded gasoline, or diesel fuel, but are open for other business, a sign shall be displayed indicating that leaded gasoline, unleaded gasoline, or diesel fuel is not being dispensed; or, in the alternative, the price signs required by subsection (a) shall be removed or covered.
- (c) Whenever a gasoline price posted as required by this section at a gasoline service station that offers both full service and self-service pumps and the posted price refers to self-service pumps only, the words "Self-service" shall appear on said sign.

Coding:

- (d) All price signs required by this section shall have letters at least one and three-quarter (1¾) inches in height, shall have numerals indicating dollars and cents per price unit at least six (6) inches in height, and shall have numerals indicating fractions of cents per price unit at least three (3) inches in height.
- (e) Price signs required by this section shall conform to all statutes, ordinances, and regulations pertaining to signs.
- (f) Every person, firm, partnership, association, trustee, or corporation which owns, operates, manages, leases, or rents a gasoline or other motor vehicle fuel station offering for sale, selling, or otherwise dispensing gasoline or other motor vehicle fuel to the public from such station shall, if the gasoline or fuel is offered for sale, sold, or dispensed in metric liters, post or cause to be posted or displayed and maintained at or on each gasoline or fuel pump a sign in numerals and letters at least one (1) inch in height, reading: 3.785 liters equals 1 gallon.
- (g) (b) Enforcement. In addition to all other penalties, remedies, or other enforcement measures provided by law, violations of this section shall be subject to civil penalties as provided by Chapter Section 8½-16 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, and penalties shall be imposed as set forth in the schedule of penalties therein.
- (h) Scope of article. The provisions of this section shall be the exclusive regulations applicable to signs indicating the price of gasoline in Broward County, except where municipalities have enacted ordinances or rules and regulations governing signs indicating the price of gasoline.
- Section 2. Section 8½-16 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:
