2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 ACCEPTING A DONATION OF MATERIALS, VALUED AT
5 APPROXIMATELY TWELVE THOUSAND DOLLARS
6 (\$12,000), FROM FRIENDS OF DEERFIELD ISLAND PARK,
7 INC., FOR THE USE AND BENEFIT OF THE PARKS AND
8 RECREATION DIVISION AT DEERFIELD ISLAND PARK
9 FOR AN EDUCATIONAL FOSSIL DIG; AUTHORIZING THE
10 COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL
11 ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS TO
12 IMPLEMENT ACCEPTANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR
13 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 WHEREAS, Friends of Deerfield Island Park, Inc., has generously agreed to
15 donate materials, valued at approximately Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000), for the
16 use and benefit of the Parks and Recreation Division for an educational fossil dig at
17 Deerfield Island Park;

18 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code provides
19 for the acceptance and acknowledgment by the Board of County Commissioners of
20 Broward County, Florida ("Board"), of donations to the County that are valued at
21 Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) or more; and

22 WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous gift and express its gratitude
23 for such donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the donation of materials with an
approximate value of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000) from Friends of Deerfield Island
Park, Inc., whose local address is 1423 E. Hillsboro Boulevard, Apt. 622, Deerfield Beach,

1 Florida 33441, for the use and benefit of the Parks and Recreation Division for an
2 educational fossil dig at Deerfield Island Park.

3 Section 2. The County Administrator is authorized to take all administrative and
4 budgetary actions required to implement acceptance of the donation in this matter.

5 Section 3. Severability.

6 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
7 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
8 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
9 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
10 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
11 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

12 Section 4. Effective Date.

13 This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
