SECTION 5310, TO PURCHASE COLLINS CUTAWAY TRANSIT VEHICLES FOR 6 PARATRANSIT SERVICES, EACH VALUED AT SIXTY-NINE FIVE HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS 7 (\$69,522); AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCÉPT THE GRANT FUNDING IF IT IS AWARDED: AND 8 PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 9 10 WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration ("FTA") allocates funds to the State of Florida each year for the 49 U.S.C. Section 5310 Grant Program ("Program"); 11 12 WHEREAS, the Program provides for the enhanced mobility of seniors and 13 individuals with disabilities; 14 WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") has been 15 designated by the Governor to administer the Program; 16 WHEREAS, Broward County has the authority to apply for and accept grant 17 awards made by FDOT and the FTA as authorized by Chapter 341, Florida Statutes, and 18 the Federal Transit Administration Act of 1964, as amended; and 19 WHEREAS, the grant requires that the applicant provide a public hearing regarding 20 the application for Section 5310 grant FDOT funding, NOW, THEREFORE, 21 22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF 23 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

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1 The Director of the Transportation Department is authorized to sign Section 1. 2 the application to the Florida Department of Transportation for federal grant program funds for State Fiscal Year 2020 pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Section 5310 to purchase Collins 3 Cutaway Transit Vehicles for paratransit services, each valued at Sixty-nine Thousand 4 Five Hundred Twenty-two Dollars (\$69,522). 5 6 Section 2. The County Administrator is authorized to accept a grant award, 7 unless this Resolution is specifically rescinded, and to sign any and all documentation approved by the Office of the County Attorney that may be required in connection with the amended grant application and award. 10 Section 3.
