Fiscal Impact Statement Re: Proposed Ordinance Amending Chapter 20 of the Broward County Code

of Ordinances, Relating to Consumer Protection Exemptions for Certain Transactions by Secondhand

Dealers

Summary

The proposal amends Chapter 20, article V of the Broward County Code of Ordinances. The proposed changes would create Sec. 20-126 which would provide exemptions relating to secondhand dealers. Specifically, the changes would apply exemption to the secondhand sale of media (such as music, movies, and games); musical instruments; video game consoles; and electronics purchased by secondhand dealers for less than \$250. The proposed changes also include additional sections to the ordinance which specify the severability, inclusion in the Broward County Code of Ordinances, and effective date.

Fiscal Impact

There is no fiscal impact to Broward County related to enforcement of this ordinance.
