FLORIDA. 3 PERTAINING TO THE PROCUREMENT CODE; AMENDING OF CHAPTER THE BROWARD 21 COUNTY 4 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE RELATING TO THE CONTRACT EXECUTION AUTHORITY 5 OF THE DIRECTOR OF PURCHASING; AND PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, **FOR** INCLUSION 6 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 7 8 WHEREAS, as amended on June 12, 2018, Chapter 21 of the Broward County 9 Administrative Code authorizes the Director of Purchasing to award bids up to \$500,000 10 where more than one bidder has submitted a response; 11 WHEREAS, Chapter 21 also authorizes the Director of Purchasing to award bids 12 above \$500,000 where no bidder has been determined to be nonresponsive or 13 nonresponsible, no protests have been filed, more than one bidder has submitted a 14 response, and no Commissioner has expressed an objection within five (5) days after 15 receiving notice of intended award from the Purchasing Division; 16 WHEREAS, the award of a bid is sometimes required to be effectuated through 17 execution of an associated contract; 18 WHEREAS, Chapter 21 does not currently expressly grant the Director of 19 Purchasing the authority to execute contracts associated with bids that the Director of 20 Purchasing has been granted the authority to award; and 21 WHEREAS, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") 22 desires to further amend the Broward County Administrative Code to provide such 23 express authority to the Director of Purchasing, NOW, THEREFORE, 24

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 21.14 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

21.14. Authority of the Director of Purchasing.

. . .

d. Execution Authority. In addition to any express delegation of power by the Board in connection with a particular procurement or expressly stated in a contract approved by the Board, the Director of Purchasing is authorized to execute the following contracts and amendments, to exercise the following extensions to and renewals of contracts, and to award the following bids, subject to any otherwise applicable durational limitations in the Code (the "Director's Execution Authority"):

)

4. Award bids up to \$500,000, including execution of any contracts associated with the award of the bid, provided that more than one bidder has submitted a response; and award bids in any amount over \$500,000, including execution of any contracts associated with the award of the bid, provided that no bidder has been determined to be nonresponsive or nonresponsible, no protests have been filed, and more than one bidder has submitted a response, and further provided that no Commissioner has expressed an objection within five (5) days after receiving notice of intended award from the Purchasing Division.

All contracts, amendments, extensions, renewals, and bids approved by the Director of Purchasing pursuant to this section may be executed by the Director of Purchasing. However, any exercise of the Director's Execution Authority above the amount of \$400,000, as calculated above, other than pursuant to subsection d.4 above, shall be executed jointly by the Director of Purchasing and the County Administrator. The Director's Execution Authority stated in this section is in addition to, and the provisions of this section do not apply to, Small Purchases procured pursuant to Section 21.33 and purchases that are subject to a delegation of authority pursuant to Section 21.15.

If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any court to
