

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, NAMING THE SEVENTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT COURT OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, JUDICIAL COMPLEX NORTH WING LOCATED AT 201 SE 6<sup>TH</sup> STREET, FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA 33301 AS THE "JUDGE THOMAS J. 'TJ' REDDICK, JR. NORTH WING" IN MEMORY OF LATE HONORABLE JUDGE THOMAS 'TJ' REDDICK, JR.; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTION TO IMPLEMENT SAME; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Thomas J. 'TJ' Reddick, Jr. was born on January 4, 1919, in Sarasota, Florida;

WHEREAS, TJ Reddick, Jr. honorably served in the United States Military for four years after graduation from Middleton High School in Tampa, Florida;

WHEREAS, TJ Reddick, Jr. received his Bachelor of Science Degree from Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University and his law degree from Howard University;

WHEREAS, TJ Reddick, Jr. was admitted to The Florida Bar on August 11, 1951, and went on to become the first African-American attorney to open a law firm in Broward County;

WHEREAS, TJ Reddick, Jr. was also the first African-American Assistant Public Defender, Municipal Judge, Court of Record Judge, and the first African-American attorney to serve by assignment on the Fourth District Court of Appeals;

WHEREAS, in 1972, TJ Reddick, Jr. became the first African-American Circuit Court Judge in the state of Florida;

1           WHEREAS, TJ Reddick, Jr. was an active member of the Chamber of Commerce,  
2 the Elks Lodge, Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., and Mount Hermon AME Church, where  
3 he served as trustee;

4           WHEREAS, TJ Reddick, Jr. as a retired Judge, served as a traffic hearing officer  
5 and presided over Small Claims Court at the North Regional County Courthouse;

6           WHEREAS, TJ Reddick, Jr. passed away in 1993, leaving three sons Conrad,  
7 Cedric, and Thomas, III; and

8           WHEREAS, on November 12, 1982, the TJ Reddick Bar Association was formed  
9 to honor and continue TJ Reddick, Jr.'s legacy and to strive for equality in court  
10 appointments in civil or criminal cases, appointments to judgeships, and to shed light on  
11 lingering issues related to diversity in the legal field, NOW, THEREFORE,

13           BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
14 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

16           Section 1. That the Board of County Commissioners hereby names the  
17 Seventeenth Judicial Circuit Court of Broward County, Florida, Judicial Complex North  
18 Wing, located at 201 SE 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301 as the "Judge Thomas  
19 J. 'TJ' Reddick, Jr. North Wing" in honor and memory of the late former Circuit Court  
20 Judge, prominent attorney, and community advocate Judge Thomas J. 'TJ' Reddick, Jr.  
21 for his many years of dedicated service to our community.

22           Section 2. That the County Administrator is authorized to take all administrative  
23 actions necessary to implement this Resolution.
