Holness) 10 11 WHEREAS, Thomas J. 'TJ' Reddick, Jr. was born on January 4, 1919, in Sarasota, 12 Florida: 13 WHEREAS. TJ Reddick, Jr. honorably served in the United States Military for four vears after graduation from Middleton High School in Tampa, Florida; 14 15 WHEREAS, TJ Reddick, Jr. received his Bachelor of Science Degree from Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University and his law degree from Howard University; 16 17 WHEREAS, TJ Reddick, Jr. was admitted to The Florida Bar on August 11, 1951, and went on to become the first African-American attorney to open a law firm in Broward 19 County: WHEREAS, TJ Reddick, Jr. was also the first African-American Assistant Public 20 21 Defender, Municipal Judge, Court of Record Judge, and the first African-American attorney to serve by assignment on the Fourth District Court of Appeals; 22 WHEREAS, in 1972, TJ Reddick, Jr. became the first African-American Circuit 23 Court Judge in the state of Florida;

WHEREAS, TJ Reddick, Jr. was an active member of the Chamber of Commerce, the Elks Lodge, Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., and Mount Hermon AME Church, where he served as trustee;

WHEREAS, TJ Reddick, Jr. as a retired Judge, served as a traffic hearing officer and presided over Small Claims Court at the North Regional County Courthouse;

WHEREAS, TJ Reddick, Jr. passed away in 1993, leaving three sons Conrad, Cedric, and Thomas, III; and

WHEREAS, on November 12, 1982, the TJ Reddick Bar Association was formed to honor and continue TJ Reddick, Jr.'s legacy and to strive for equality in court appointments in civil or criminal cases, appointments to judgeships, and to shed light on lingering issues related to diversity in the legal field, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF **BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:**

Section 1. That the Board of County Commissioners hereby names the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit Court of Broward County, Florida, Judicial Complex North 18 Wing, located at 201 SE 6th Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301 as the "Judge Thomas" J. 'TJ' Reddick, Jr. North Wing" in honor and memory of the late former Circuit Court Judge, prominent attorney, and community advocate Judge Thomas J. 'TJ' Reddick, Jr. for his many years of dedicated service to our community.

That the County Administrator is authorized to take all administrative Section 2. actions necessary to implement this Resolution.
