3	COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO MOTOR CARRIER CIVIL PENALTIES; AMENDING SECTION 8½-16 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY
4	CODE OF ORDINANCES ("CODE"); INCREASING FINES
5	FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE CODE RELATED TO ILLEGAL SOLICITATION; REMOVING CIVIL PENALTIES FOR
6	TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANIES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

9	WHEREAS, illegal ride solicitation has become an increasing regulatory challenge
10	in Broward County's vehicle-for-hire industry;
11	WHEREAS, Section 162.09, Florida Statutes, permits Broward County to set fines
12	for violations of the Broward County Code of Ordinances ("Code") at up to \$1,000 for an
13	initial violation and up to \$5,000 for each repeat violation;
14	WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida
15	("Board"), desires to deter illegal ride solicitation by increasing civil fines for violations of
16	the Code related to illegal ride solicitation to \$1,000 for first-time violations and \$5,000 for
17	each repeat violation;
18	WHEREAS, Section 81/2-16 of the Code also prescribes civil penalties for
19	transportation network companies;
20	WHEREAS, Broward County no longer regulates transportation network
21	companies due to state preemption;
22	WHEREAS, the Board desires to remove provisions related to transportation
23	network companies from the Code; and

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 8½-16 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Ordinance become part of the Broward County Code of Ordinances as of the effective date. The sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word
