County Board of County Commissioners (the "Commissioners"), at its regularly scheduled meeting on February 26, 2019 at 10:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the same may be heard, at 115 South Andrews Avenue, Room 422, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301, for the purposes of receiving comments and hearing discussion concerning the issuance from time to time in one or more tax-exempt and taxable series pursuant to a plan of financing by the Capital Trust Agency (the "CTA") of its Educational Facilities Revenue Bonds (Paragon Academy of Technology and Sunshine Elementary Charter School Project), in an amount not to exceed \$8,500,000 (the "Bonds"), the proceeds of which shall be loaned by the CTA to Sunshine Elementary Charter School, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit corporation (the "Borrower") and applied by the Borrower to pay the costs of the (a) acquisition, renovation, installation and equipping, together with the acquisition and installation of related facilities, fixtures, furnishing and equipment, of an approximately 36,766 square-foot existing charter school facility (the "Facility") occupied by two charter schools known as Paragon Academy of Technology, with capacity for approximately 500 students in grades 6-12 (the "Paragon Space"), and Sunshine Elementary Charter School, with capacity for approximately 500 students in grades 6-10 (the "Paragon Space"), and Sunshine Elementary Charter School, with capacity for approximately 500 students in grades 6-10 (the "Paragon Space") (cated on approximately 445 acres of land at 502 N. 28th Avenue, Hollywood, Florida 33020, within the territorial limits of Broward County, Florida; (b) the funding of a debt service reserve fund for the Bonds, and (c) the payment of certain costs of issuing the Bonds (the purposes described in clauses (a) through (c) are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Project").

The Bonds are expected to be issued pursuant to the Act (as hereinafter defined) by the CTA, a legal entity and public agency of the State of Florida, organized under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 163, Part I, Chapter 166, Part II, and Chapter 617, Florida Statutes; Ordinance No. 5-97 duly enacted by the City Council of the City of Gulf Breeze, Florida (the "City"), on July 7, 1997, as amended, restated and supplemented; Ordinance No. 2-00 duly enacted by the Town Council of the Town of Century, Florida (the "Town") on August 7, 2000, as amended and supplemented; an interlocal Agreement dated as of August 2, 1999, between the City and the Town, as amended and supplemented, and with powers as a "local agency" under Chapter 159, Part II, Florida Statutes, and other applicable provisions of law (collectively, the "Act").

The Bonds will be special limited obligations of the CTA payable solely from the trust estate which includes loan repayments to be made by the Borrower to the CTA, and certain moneys and securities on deposit in the funds and accounts held by the trustee under the terms of a trust indenture for the Bonds. The Pacility will be owned by the Borrower. The Borrower, or an affiliate thereof or another entity chosen by the Borrower will be the initial operator of the Sunshine Space and Paragon Academy of Technology, Inc. ("Paragon"), a Florida not-for-profit corporation, or an affiliate thereof or another entity chosen by Paragon will be the initial operator of the Paragon Space. Paragon will lease the Paragon Space from the Borrower and make lease payments directly to the trustee as part of the trust estate.

The Bonds will not be a debt or liability of Broward County, the State of Florida or any political subdivision thereof, and neither Broward County, the State of Florida or any political subdivision thereof, and neither Broward County, the State of Florida or early political subdivision thereof, shall have any payment responsibility whatsoever in connection with the Bonds. The Bonds shall be special limited obligations of the CTA, payable solely from the trust estate.
