

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO THE PARATRANSIT FARE STRUCTURE; AMENDING SECTION 41.04 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE") TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT PER TRIP ON THE SUBSIDIZED PAYMENT CARD; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Proposed

WHEREAS, at its meeting on January 29, 2019, on Item 62, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), approved the continuation of the Paratransit Rider's Choice Pilot Program for two (2) additional years, expanded enrollment by removing the 150-person limit, and increased the per-trip subsidy from \$15.00 to \$18.00;

WHEREAS, the Board desires to amend Section 41.04 of the Administrative Code to reflect the increased per-trip subsidy for the Paratransit Rider's Choice Pilot Program; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the revisions to the Administrative Code as set forth herein are necessary and in the best interest of Broward County, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 41.04 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

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41.04. Paratransit Fare Structure.

The Paratransit fare structure shall be as follows:

	<i>Fee</i>
a. Designated nutrition site trips	\$0.00
b. ADA Paratransit trips shall not exceed twice the fare that would be charged to an individual paying full fare on fixed route up to a maximum of	\$3.50
c. Veterans Administration Clinic site trips within the Broward County service area for Paratransit eligible Veterans	\$1.75
d. Subsidized transportation card. County payment shall not exceed \$15.00 <u>\$18.00</u> per trip.	
e. Annual Bus Pass for eligible Transportation Disadvantaged customers (TD Bus Passes).....	\$0.00

Section 2. Severability.

If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Administrative Code Resolution. If any court determines that this Administrative Code Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Administrative Code Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 3. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative

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1 Code as of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may
2 be renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution" may be changed to "section,"
3 "article," or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary in order to
4 accomplish such intention.
