FLORIDA. $\mathsf{THE}$ **PARATRANSIT** PERTAINING 3 STRUCTURE: AMENDING SECTION 41.04 ADMINISTRATIVE BROWARD COUNTY 4 ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE") TΟ INCREASE MAXIMUM AMOUNT PER TRIP ON THE SUBSIDIZED 5 PAYMENT CARD; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN 6 EFFECTIVE DATE. 7 8 WHEREAS, at its meeting on January 29, 2019, on Item 62, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), approved the continuation of the Paratransit Rider's Choice Pilot Program for two (2) additional years, expanded 10 enrollment by removing the 150-person limit, and increased the per-trip subsidy from 11 12 \$15.00 to \$18.00; 13 WHEREAS, the Board desires to amend Section 41.04 of the Administrative 14 Code to reflect the increased per-trip subsidy for the Paratransit Rider's Choice Pilot 15 Program; and 16 WHEREAS, the Board finds that the revisions to the Administrative Code as set forth herein are necessary and in the best interest of Broward County, NOW, 17 18 THEREFORE, 19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF 20 21 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA: 22 23 Section 1.
