RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY. FLORIDA. ACCEPTING A DONATION IN THE AMOUNT OF TWELVE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$12,750) FROM THE SUN-SENTINEL CHILDREN'S **LIBRARY** THROUGH THE **BROWARD PUBLIC** FOUNDATION, INC., FOR THE USE AND BENEFIT OF THE LITERACY **CENTERS** HELP ΑT THE FOLLOWING LIBRARIES: JAN MORAN COLLIER CITY LEARNING LIBRARY, TAMARAC BRANCH, LAUDERHILL CENTRE AND AFRICAN-AMERICAN RESEARCH LIBRARY AND CULTURAL CENTER; AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR COUNTY TO TAKE **BUDGETARY ACTIONS** ADMINISTRATIVE AND IMPLEMENT ACCEPTANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Sun-Sentinel Children's Fund through the Broward Public Library Foundation, Inc., has most generously offered to donate to the County Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$12,750), for the use and benefit of the Literacy Help Centers at the following libraries: Jan Moran Collier City Learning Library, Tamarac Branch, Lauderhill Towne Centre, and African-American Research Library and Cultural Center; and

WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code provides for the acceptance and acknowledgement by the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), of donations to the County that are valued at Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) or more; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the donation of \$12,750 from the Sun-Sentinel Children's Fund through the Broward Public Library Foundation, Inc., whose address is 100 South Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301, for the use and benefit of the Literacy Help Centers at the following libraries: Jan Moran Collier City Learning Library, Tamarac Branch, Lauderhill Towne Centre, and African-American Research Library and Cultural Center.

Section 2. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to take all administrative and budgetary actions and execute all forms required to implement acceptance of the donation.
