2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 ACCEPTING A DONATION IN THE AMOUNT OF TWELVE
5 THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$12,750)
6 FROM THE SUN-SENTINEL CHILDREN'S FUND
7 THROUGH THE BROWARD PUBLIC LIBRARY
8 FOUNDATION, INC., FOR THE USE AND BENEFIT OF THE
9 LITERACY HELP CENTERS AT THE FOLLOWING
10 LIBRARIES: JAN MORAN COLLIER CITY LEARNING
LIBRARY, TAMARAC BRANCH, LAUDERHILL TOWNE
CENTRE, AND AFRICAN-AMERICAN RESEARCH
LIBRARY AND CULTURAL CENTER; AUTHORIZING THE
COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL
ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS TO
IMPLEMENT ACCEPTANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR
SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

11 WHEREAS, the Sun-Sentinel Children's Fund through the Broward Public Library
12 Foundation, Inc., has most generously offered to donate to the County Twelve Thousand
13 Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$12,750), for the use and benefit of the Literacy Help
14 Centers at the following libraries: Jan Moran Collier City Learning Library, Tamarac
15 Branch, Lauderhill Towne Centre, and African-American Research Library and Cultural
16 Center; and

17 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code provides
18 for the acceptance and acknowledgement by the Board of County Commissioners of
19 Broward County, Florida ("Board"), of donations to the County that are valued at Ten
20 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) or more; and

21 WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous gift, and to express its
22 gratitude for such donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

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1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
2 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

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4 Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the donation of \$12,750 from the
5 Sun-Sentinel Children's Fund through the Broward Public Library Foundation, Inc., whose
6 address is 100 South Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301, for the use and
7 benefit of the Literacy Help Centers at the following libraries: Jan Moran Collier City
8 Learning Library, Tamarac Branch, Lauderhill Towne Centre, and African-American
9 Research Library and Cultural Center.

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11 Section 2. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to take all
12 administrative and budgetary actions and execute all forms required to implement
13 acceptance of the donation.

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15 Section 3. Severability.

16 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
17 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
18 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
19 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
20 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
21 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

1 Section 4. Effective Date.

2 This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
