RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY. FLORIDA. DESIGNATING THE KAYE STEVENS HOUSE (HOUSE NO. 1) A HISTORIC RESOURCE; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, an Application for Designation of a Historic Resource ("Application") was submitted to the Broward County Historic Preservation Board ("HPB") regarding the Kaye Stevens House (House No. 1) (the "Site"), which Site is assigned Tax Identification Number 4841-25-03-2020:

WHEREAS, the HPB considered the Application on September 20, 2018, during a public hearing held by the HPB pursuant to Section 5-533 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances;

WHEREAS, based upon testimony and evidence presented at the public hearing held by the HPB, the HPB recommended that the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida (the "Board"), designate the Site as a historic resource;

WHEREAS, the Board considered the application and the HPB recommendation at a public hearing held on April 16, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the findings of fact contained within the Order Recommending Historic Resource Designation to the Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Order"), attached hereto as Exhibit "A," are adopted and incorporated herein by reference as findings for eligibility of an individual historic resource, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF

 Section 1. Based upon testimony and evidence presented to the Board at a public hearing and the findings of fact contained within the Order, and pursuant to Section 5-534 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, the Kaye Stevens House (House No. 1), as more thoroughly described in Attachment "A" to the Order and which is a portion of the property assigned Tax Identification Number 4841-25-03-2020, is hereby designated as a historic resource.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be forwarded to the Broward County Planning Council for review and consideration for designation as a Cultural Resource/Local Area of Particular Concern on the Broward County Land Use Plan Map Series.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be recorded in the public records of Broward County, Florida, and the obligations, restrictions, and requirements of Section 5-530 et seq., of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, shall run with the Site.

Section 4. The County Administrator, or designee, shall notify the City Manager of the City of Margate, Florida, that the Board has designated the Site as a historic resource and of the requirements of Section 5-530 et seq., of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, including, but not limited to, the requirement for any developer(s) of the Site to obtain a Certificate of Appropriateness or a Certificate to Dig, pursuant to Sections 5-536 and 5-536.5 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, prior to the issuance of any permits for alteration, construction, relocation, demolition, land disturbance, or development of the Site.

Section 5. <u>Severability</u>.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in

- (3) The information contained within the Application is found to be true and adopted and incorporated herein by reference as findings for eligibility of an individual historic resource; and

(4) The Site meets the criteria for designation as a historic resource pursuant to

Section 5-533 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances.
