ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY ΑN 2 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA. PERTAINING TO THE WASHINGTON PARK, ROOSEVELT 3 AND GARDENS BOULEVARD GARDENS NEIGHBORHOOD PRESERVATION AND ENHANCEMENT 4 DISTRICTS: REPEALING ORDINANCES AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN  $\mathsf{THE}$ NEIGHBORHOOD 5 PRESERVATION AND ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM, CREATING THE NEIGHBORHOOD PRESERVATION AND 6 **ENHANCEMENT** DISTRICTS, **AND** ADOPTING ASSOCIATED NEIGHBORHOOD ENHANCEMENT PLANS 7 AND AMENDMENTS THERETO: AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 8

(Sponsored by the Board of County Commissioners)

WHEREAS, Section 163.524, Florida Statutes, provides that any municipality or county may adopt local ordinances authorizing its participation in the Neighborhood Preservation and Enhancement Program, creating a Neighborhood Preservation and Enhancement District, and adopting a Neighborhood Enhancement Plan and amendments thereto;

WHEREAS, on January 14, 1997, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") enacted Ordinance No. 97-03, authorizing participation by Broward County in the Neighborhood Preservation and Enhancement Program;

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2001, January 28, 2003, and January 24, 2006, the Board enacted Ordinance No. 2001-07, Ordinance No. 2003-05, and Ordinance No. 2006-03, authorizing the creation of the Washington Park, Roosevelt Gardens, and Boulevard Gardens Neighborhood Preservation and Enhancement Districts, respectively;

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2002, March 9, 2004, and April 24, 2007, the Board enacted Ordinance No. 2002-44, Ordinance No. 2004-06, and Ordinance No. 2007-03, adopting the Washington Park Neighborhood Enhancement Plan, the Roosevelt Gardens Neighborhood Enhancement Plan, and the Boulevard Gardens Neighborhood Enhancement Plan (collectively "Neighborhood Enhancement Plans"), respectively;

WHEREAS, the Board has subsequently enacted Ordinance Nos. 2003-26 and 2004-12 amending the Washington Park Neighborhood Enhancement Plan; Ordinance Nos. 2005-05, 2006-02, and 2009-24 amending the Roosevelt Gardens Neighborhood Enhancement Plan, and Ordinance Nos. 2008-50 and 2010-60 amending the Boulevard Gardens Neighborhood Enhancement Plan;

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2012, the Board enacted Ordinance No. 2012-25, creating the "Central County Community Overlay District" in the Broward Municipal Services District neighborhoods of Washington Park, Roosevelt Gardens, Boulevard Gardens, and Franklin Park;

WHEREAS, the Central County Community Overlay District incorporates the requirements of the Neighborhood Enhancement Plans, thereby making retention of the Neighborhood Enhancement Plans redundant;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 163.524(11), Florida Statutes, on February 22, 2019, the Environmental Protection and Growth Management Department, as the planning agency for Broward County, and the Neighborhood Councils held a joint public meeting, with due public notice, regarding this proposed Ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection and Growth Management Department, as the local planning agency for the elements of the Broward County Comprehensive Plan for the unincorporated area, held its public hearing on February 22, 2019, regarding the consistency of the proposed Ordinance with the adopted Broward County Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it in the best interest of the residents of Broward County to repeal the ordinances authorizing participation in the Neighborhood Preservation and Enhancement Program; creating the Washington Park, Roosevelt Gardens, and Boulevard Gardens Neighborhood Preservation and Enhancement Districts; and adopting the Neighborhood Enhancement Plans and all amendments thereto,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The following ordinances are hereby repealed in their entirety:
